

## **Butte County Public Health Department offers School-Based Pandemic H1N1 Flu Vaccination Clinic to Durham Unified School District students**

Butte County Public Health Department will be offering pandemic H1N1 flu (swine flu) vaccinations for students who attend a school within Durham Unified School District. Vaccine is being offered to children through a school-based clinic because school-aged children are at higher risk for pandemic H1N1 flu. Parents must be present for children to be vaccinated. Vaccine will only be provided to our students grades K-12.

**Date: Monday November 9th**

**Time: 3:00 – 7:00 p.m.**

**Location: Durham Elementary School Cafeteria**

Healthy children may receive the H1N1 nasal spray or injectable vaccine. Some children should receive only the injectable vaccine (the flu shot), particularly those that have a serious chronic illness such as asthma or other lung disease, heart disease, diabetes, cancer, or problems with the immune system. Other screening questions will be asked at the vaccination clinic to determine if your child should have the nasal spray or a flu shot. Children 9 years of age or less will need a second dose of flu vaccine, given at least 3-4 weeks after the first dose. Information regarding the second dose will be available at the clinic.
